Learn Grammar Future Facts with Will


Use will to talk about future facts.

Affirmative	I/You/He/She/It/We/They will be here at ten o'clock.
Negative	I / You / He / She / It / We / They won't be here at ten o'clock.
Questions	Will I / you / he / she / it / we / they be here at ten o'clock?
Short answers	Yes, I / you / he / she / it / we / they will.
	No, I / you / he / she / it / we / they won't.

Verbs don't change in the third person after will. Look:

I / You / We / They will wake up at seven o'clock tomorrow.

He / She / It will wake up at seven o'clock tomorrow.



Paulo I'm going to the airport soon. Tomorrow,

in Bangkok,

You're so lucky! 2 \_\_\_\_ a long flight? Eva

Yes, 3 \_\_\_\_. I'll be on the plane for more Paulo

than 20 hours.

Wow! When do you leave Mexico City? Eva

Paulo At four o'clock this afternoon. So 4\_

in Bangkok at noon tomorrow.

Eva Well, 5 \_\_\_\_ noon here, but it will be midnight in Bangkok.

Paulo Really?

Yes. There's a twelve-hour time difference. When it's two o'clock in the afternoon Eva

in Mexico City, 6 \_\_\_\_\_ two o'clock in the morning in Bangkok.
